



## Foreign Travel Advice

Travel to Georgia remains safe despite reports within the media concerning recent demonstrations.

The Government of Georgia is taking precautionary measures to guarantee the safety of travellers in Tbilisi and throughout the country. All tourist destinations and attractions are open for visitors. Furthermore, tourist infrastructure and transportation services operate without interruptions. No closures on highways or tertiary roads are observed. **Safety notice:** Following previous unrest in front of Parliament, visitors are advised to practice general precaution norms such as avoiding any large gatherings in the central part of Tbilisi (*Parliament Building, Rustaveli Ave., Liberty Sq.*) on June 21-22, even though such events are usually well policed.
